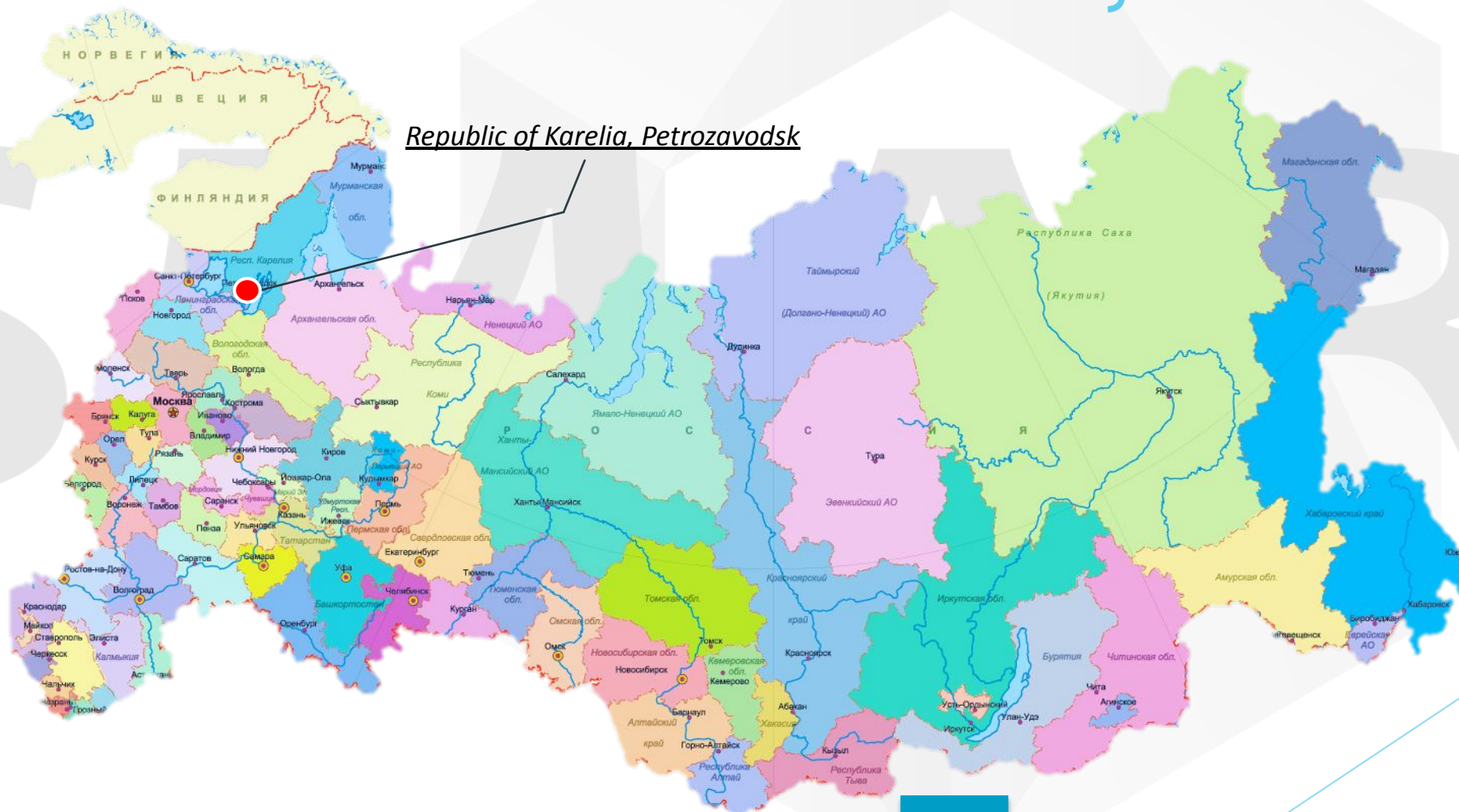

Petrozavodsk State University: location



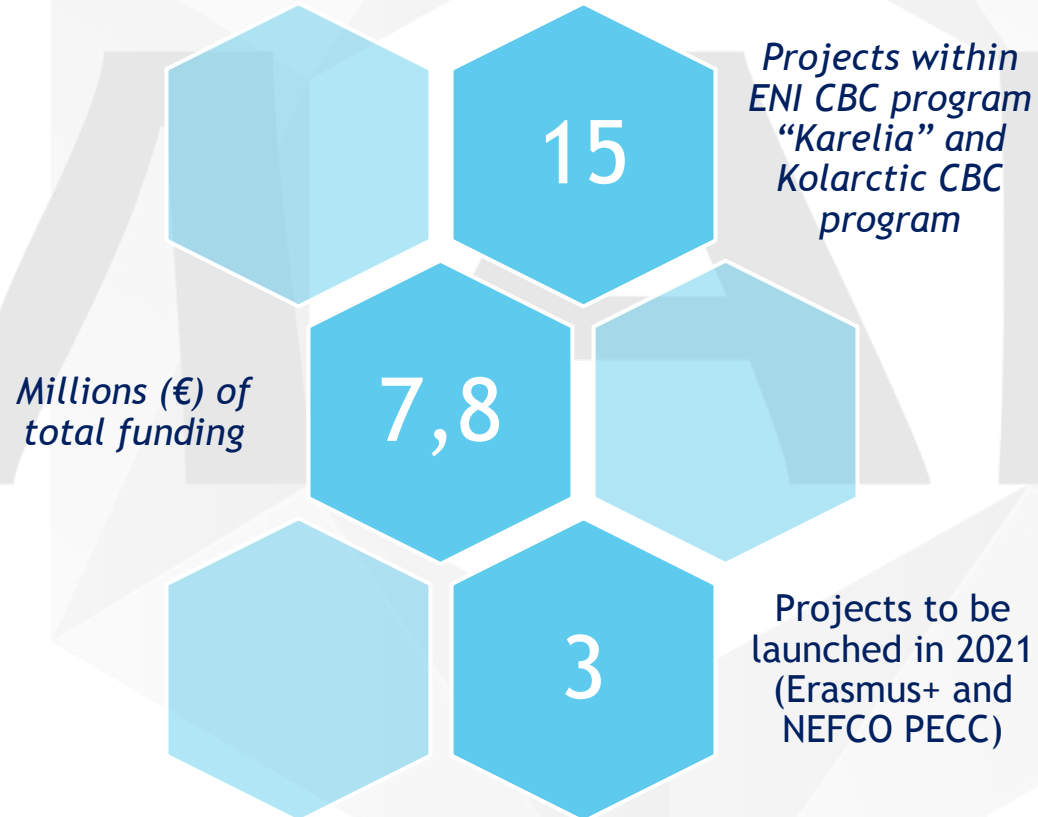
